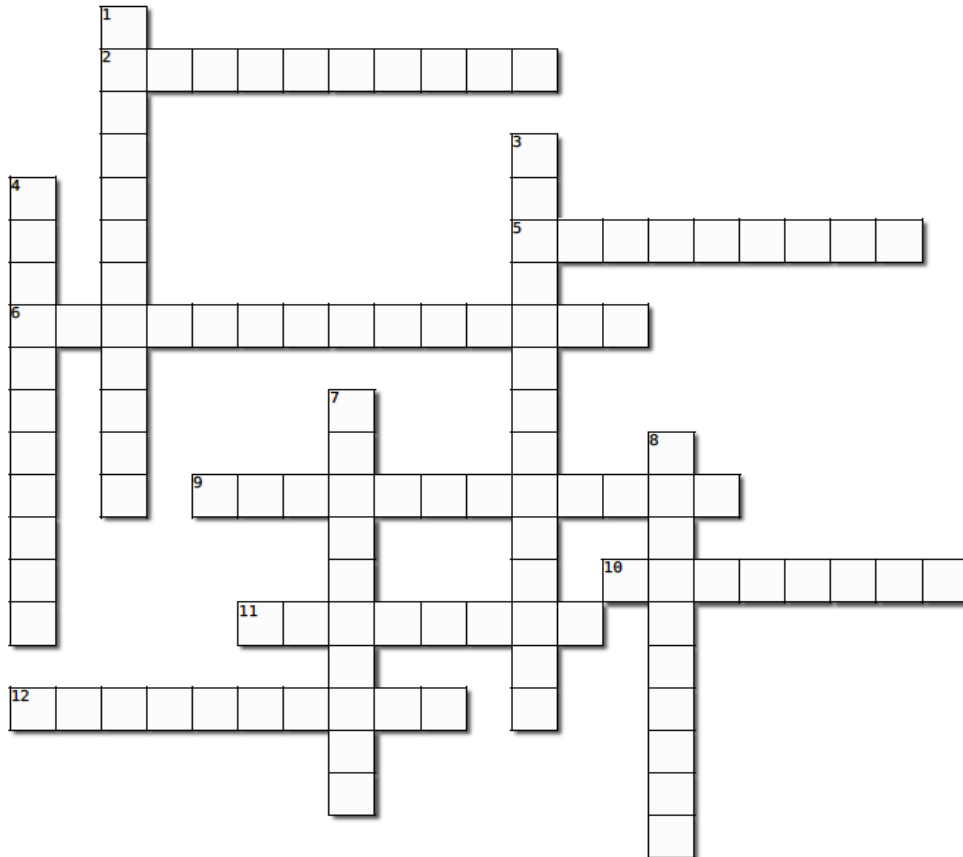




Complete the crossword puzzle using the words at the bottom of the page

starvation	suffering or death caused by lack of food.

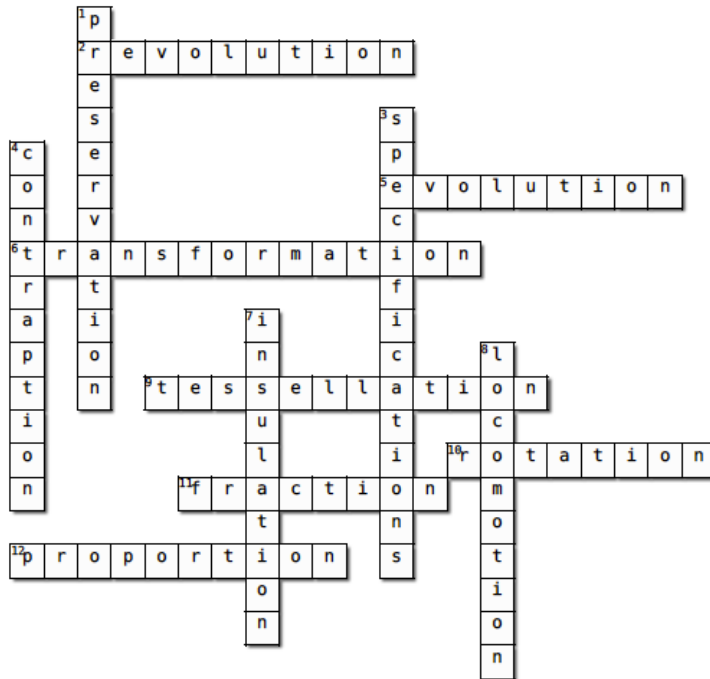

Spelling tip: The majority of words with the 'shun' sound at the end are spelled with the suffix -tion. Words that have the 'jun' sound at the end are spelled with the suffix -sion.

Words that have the word 'mission' in them are spelled using the suffix -sion. For example: admission, commission, emission
