Definitions

audience: a group of people gathered to see or hear something

difference: the result of a subtraction operation

preference: a greater liking for one alternative over another or others.

reference: a source of information

sequence: a set of numbers or shapes in a pattern

science: a system of studying, testing, and experimenting on things in nature

subsistence: the source, or means of sustenance; that which supports life or continued operation

perishable: likely to spoil or rot in a short time

recyclable: to put through a process that allows used things to be reused

renewable: to make like new; restore

vegetable: a plant or part of a plant used as food, such as a cabbage, potato, turnip, or bean.

Spelling tip: The suffix -ence / -ance: used to form nouns that refer to an action or series of actions. Words ending in these suffixes are usually nouns.
