

Spelling tips about prefixes com, con, di, in, tetra, trans, under

com- means "with," "together" (e.g. compassion)

con- means "with" or "thoroughly," (e.g. confident)

di- means "two, double, twice (e.g. dialogue)

in- before -b-, -m-, -p- means "not, opposite of" (e.g. immobile, impersonal).

It also means "in, on or not" (e.g. increase, inventory, investigate)

tetra- means "four" (e.g. tetrahedron)

trans- means "across, over, or beyond" (e.g. transformer)

under- means "less, lower, not enough, beneath, or below" (e.g. underscore)
