Alphabet Story

An alphabet conversation is a story that is told by a few players. Each player adds a sentence to the story. The sentence must begin with the letter of the alphabet. The conversation ends when you reach the letter 'z'. See how many words you can use in your alphabet conversation.

Here's how to play:

- **The first player begins by making a sentence.**
The first word of the sentence must begin with the letter **A**
- **The next player continues the story.**
The first word of their sentence begins with the letter **B**
- **Each player begins continues to take turns until you reach the letter Z.**

Use the words on your word list below. The definitions will help you. You can include words that you already know. But, try and use as many words on the list.

Here is an example of how to do an alphabet conversation:

Around 7:00 pm last night there was load shedding.

But I hadn't finished my homework.

Could somebody please help me?

Dad got up from his chair to help.

Everyone offered to help.

Fortunately, we had charged our solar lamps.

Great! We got the solar lamps out the closet and I was able to finish my homework.

Here's how you score:

1-10 words- Nice. Keep going

11-15 words- Very good!

16-20 words- Awesome!
